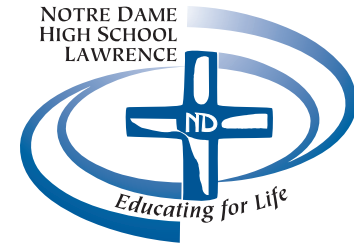
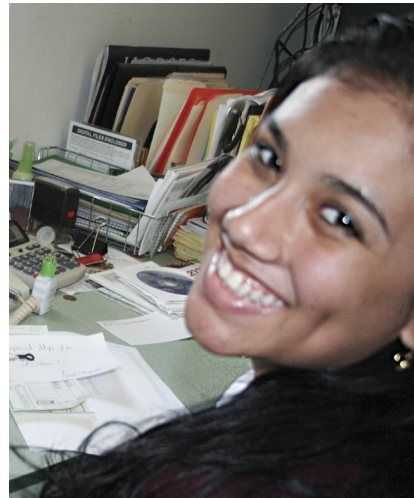
GOAL IV
